

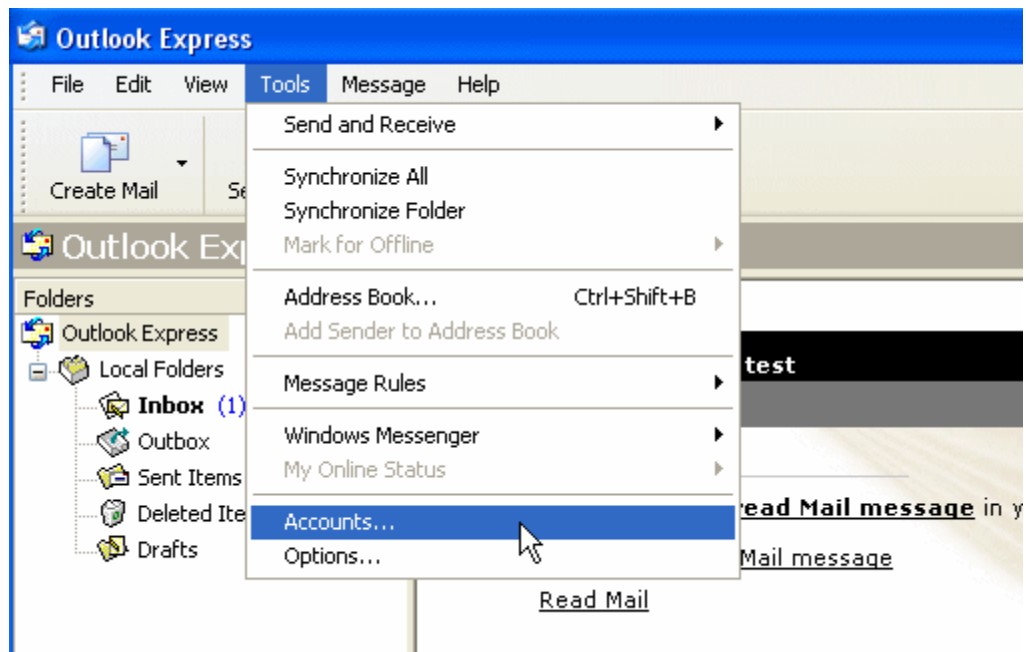
Outlook Express setup:

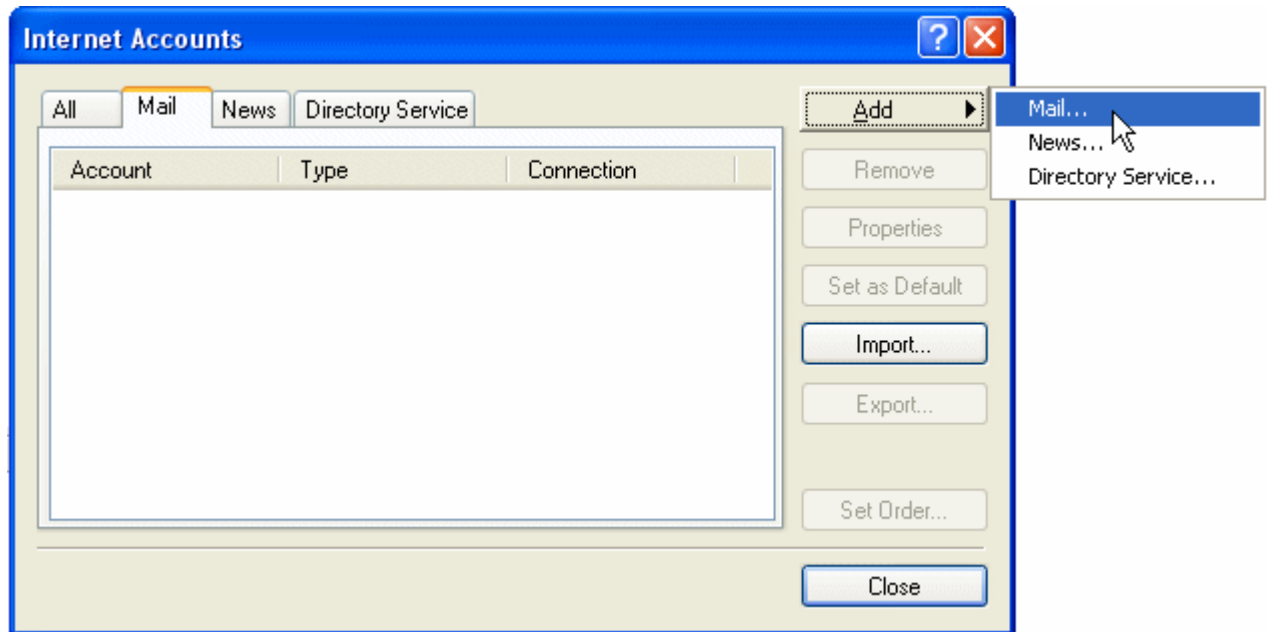
- (Incoming Mail) Server: mail.avantek.net

Configure Outlook Express:

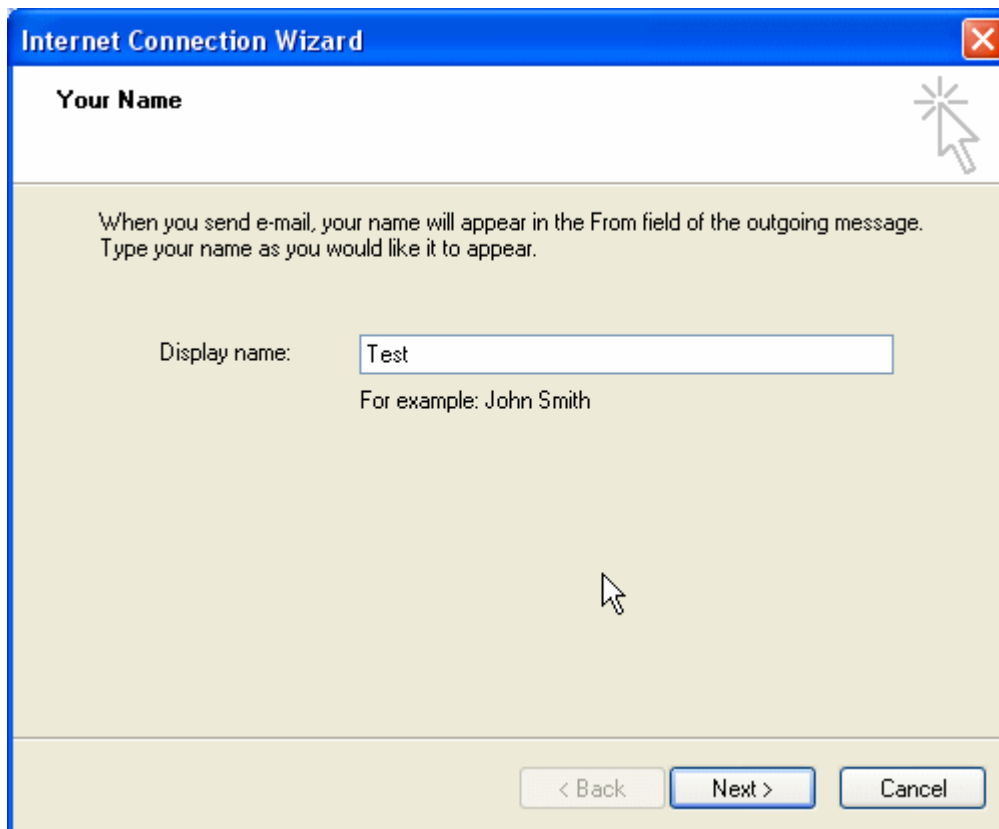
1. Open Outlook Express
2. Click on Tools, then choose Accounts




3. Click on the Mail tab, then click Add, then Mail



4. Type in your name for Display Name (this is the name recipients will see when they receive an e-mail from you).
Click Next




5. Type in your e-mail address.
Click Next



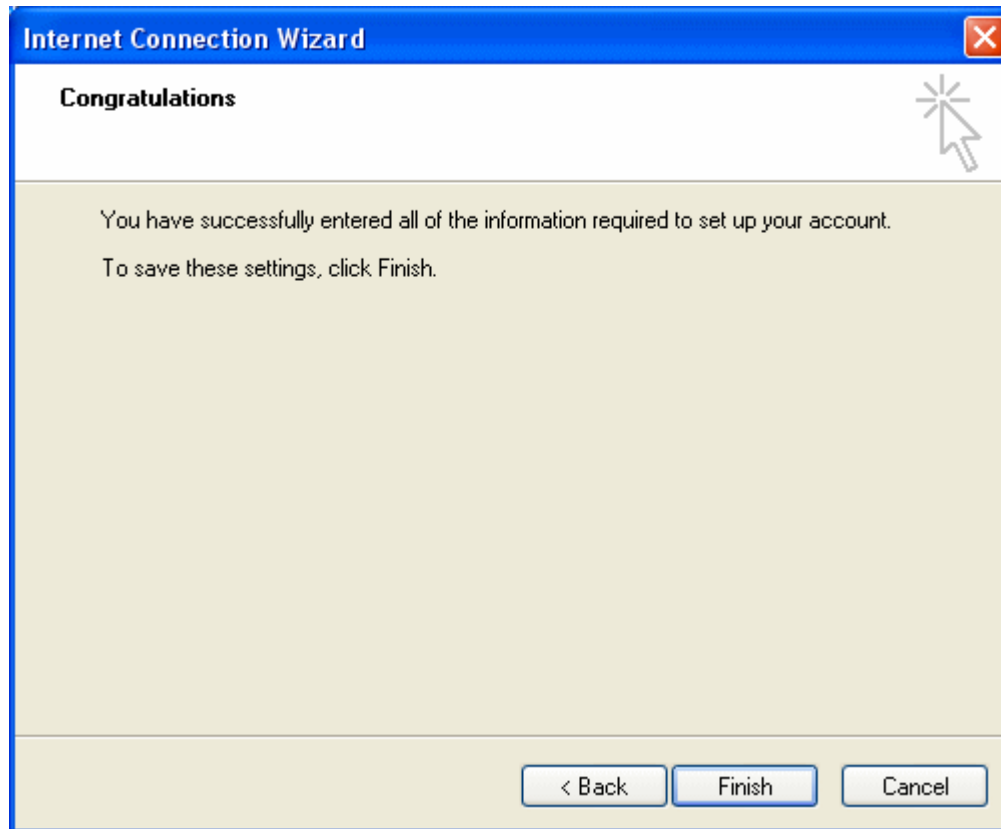
7. In the Account name box, type in your username (e.g. test@avantek.net would type in test)
